2.2 Competition and warm up format

The Guimarães International Tournament consists of:
Qualifications (CI) and Team Finals (CIV) Competition for juniors and seniors:







- There will be separate competitions and classification for juniors and seniors.
- Each team must present at least 2 routines per apparatus.
- 3 – 3 – 2 system
- Every NF may register more than one team and/or Individual gymnasts (without a team) are accepted.
- This competition is organized by a rotation of groups. A group comprises a team of up to 3 gymnasts entered by national federations or individual gymnasts of different federations.
- FIG Competition III rules will be applied for qualification to the finals on vault.
- In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules as set up for all FIG competitions shall be applied (Technical Regulations, Section 2).







Apparatus Finals (CIII) for juniors and seniors:

- There will be separate competitions and classification for juniors and seniors.
- The best six gymnasts per apparatus from the qualifications qualify for the Finals
- Participation is limited to 2 gymnasts per NF and each apparatus.
- FIG Competition III rules will be applied for vault.
 In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules as set up for all FIG competitions shall be applied (Technical Regulations, Section 2).

2.6 *Scoring*

Scoring will be assured by SIPIGym© scoring system.

An instruction for how to use the system for all judges, will be carried out on June 17th, at 12H45, in the competition hall.

2.7 *Inquiries*

Inquiries for the difficulty scores will be allowed.

The detailed procedure is laid down in the respective Appendix of the MAG and WAG Code of Points. In case of any contradiction FIG Technical Regulations will prevail.

2.8 *Medical and paramedical assistance*

Medical and paramedical assistance will be available for all gymnasts during trainings and competitions on site.

2.9 *Prize money*

The Prize Money, free of any deductible taxes, will be distributed in EURO as follows **only for the senior:**

Should there be a tie in any place, the combined prize money for the place in question and subsequent one is split between the tied gymnasts.

The Portuguese Gymnastics Federation will transfer the Prize money to the National Federations bank account.
